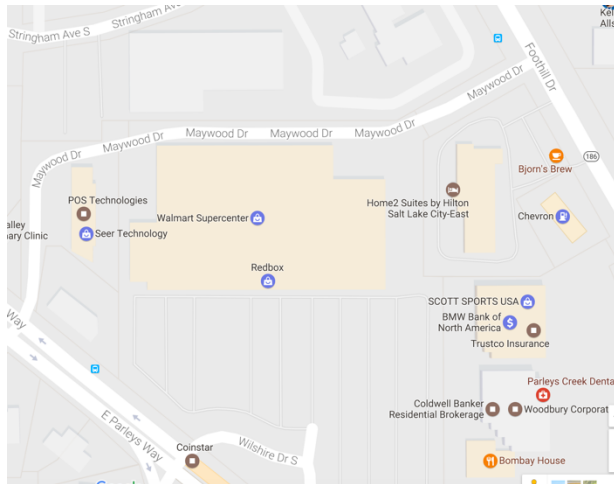

#### **Navigation and Parking Instructions:**

Lineagen is located West of Walmart in a brown brick building. From Parley's Way, you will see a brown brick building with the address 2677. Please drive up the road west of the 2677 building (called Maywood drive on maps) and turn at the 2<sup>nd</sup> right on the upper parking deck. 2681 is the first building directly in front of you when you turn right off Maywood drive. You can park anywhere on the upper parking deck or in the parking lot West of Walmart. The conference is located in the same building indicated where Seer and POS Technologies are listed on the map below.

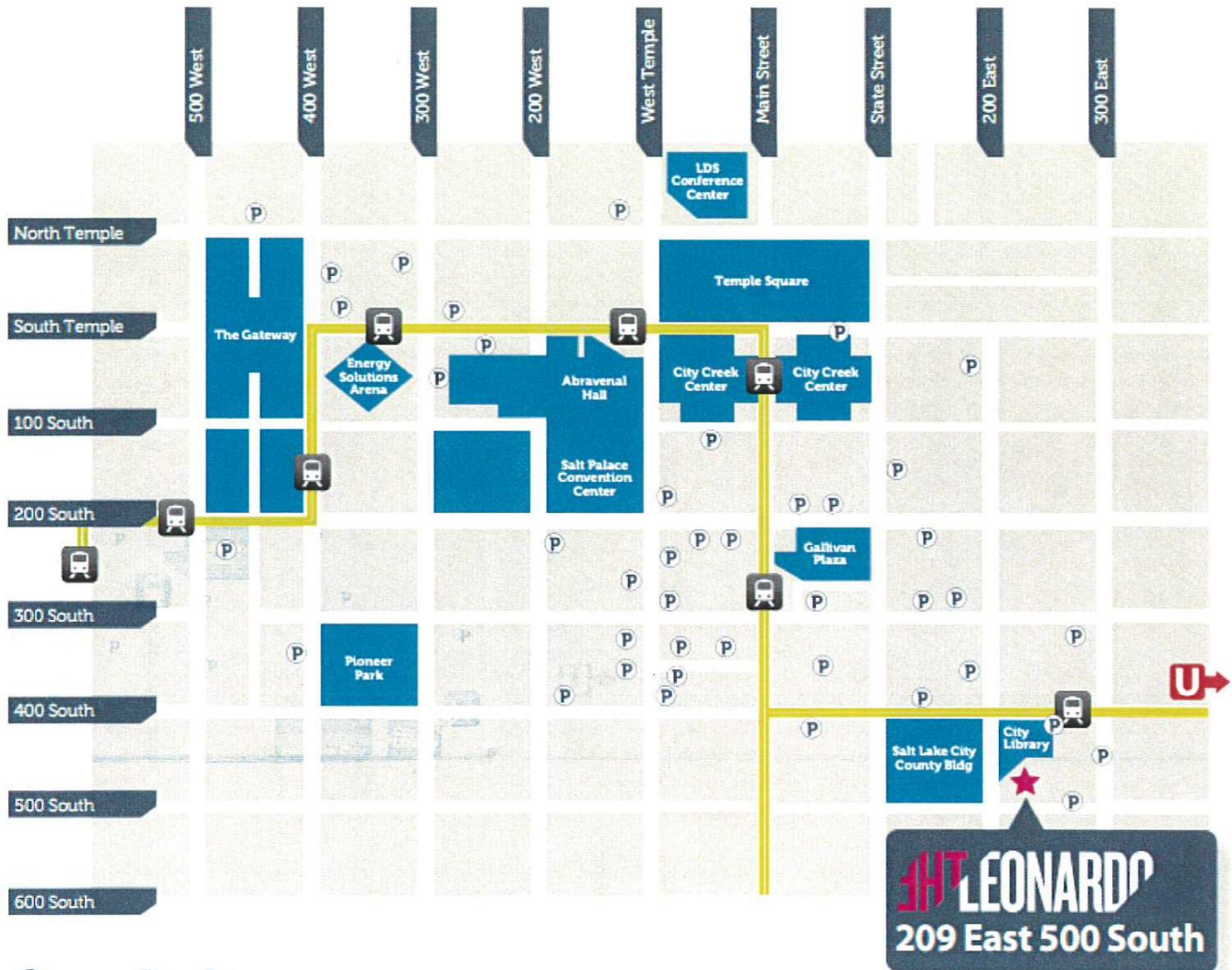

## Guest Parking

### Paid Parking

The underground Library Square lot can be accessed on the south side of 400 S. There are several other lots available near The Leonardo.

### Free Parking

There are free two-hour meter parking available on weekends. There is limited parking available on some residential streets near The Leo.

### Street Parking

Street meter parking is available around on the blocks surrounding The Leonardo. Meters vary from 30-minutes to two hours.

### Handicap Parking

Stalls for those requiring handicap access are available on 200 E and in the Library Square underground parking garage.

### Bus and Shuttle Groups

Bus drop-off zone located on the east side of 200 E. Free street parking for buses and chaperone cars is available one block south of The Leonardo on 600 S. between 200 E. and 400 E. Paid parking for cars is also available in the underground parking garage (entrance 400 S.)
